# Company

• Cast of 11 performers/technicians.

# Running Time

- MUCH ADO ABOUT NOTHING
  - Full-length performance: TBD.

Student-length performance: 90 minutes plus post-show discussion

# General

- Set-up: 2 hours plus ½ hour house.
- Strike: up to two hours.
- Performance fee balance, house counts, and any relevant publicity materials produced by Presenter (advertisements, programs, press releases) must be available to the Company Manager prior to National Players departure from your venue.

# Access

- National Players Company Manager will telephone designated Person in Charge in two weeks in advance of the performance to confirm the company's arrival time, technical requirements, and answer any questions.
- Producer requires a minimum of four (4) able-bodied persons to assist in the unloading and setting up of equipment and costumes on arrival and striking and reloading same after the performance(s), as well as two technicians (one Electrician and one Sound Engineer) familiar with house systems.
- The distance from the loading dock to the stage must be less than 100'..
- Stage area, loading doors and dressing rooms need to be cleared to allow the company to begin set up immediately upon arrival.
- Stage should be swept. A black stage floor is preferred.
- If chairs or bleachers need to be set up, it would facilitate matters if this could be done prior to National Players arrival. If equipment must be loaded in across the audience area, leave access to the stage until the load-in is finished.
- Please make arrangements for easy access to your loading door so that our vehicles will have no
  obstructions. Also please provide parking spaces for the two vans and car that carry the actors and their
  materials.

# Hospitality

- National Players does not require food provided by the Presenter, however bottled water and small snacks are always appreciated.
- Information regarding availability of guest passes or discounts to local gyms, pools, restaurants, hotels or merchants as well as local events and performances is welcome.

# Special Events and Publicity

- No filming, taping, recording or reproduction of the performance is permitted without prior written consent from the National Players General Manager.
- With advance notification, National Players may be available on the day of performance for reasonable publicity schemes to promote the engagement. This may include, but is not limited to interviews. All arrangements should be made through National Players General Manager.
- Telephone interviews may be scheduled prior to the performance depending on company availability. All arrangements should be made through National Players General Manager.

# Physical Requirements

- Required dimensions of stage 25' wide x 25' deep x 14' high. These dimensions refer to an unimpeded space, free of hanging lights or heating ducts.
- The stage floor should be free and clear of any cables and equipment, and preferably painted black.
- Our flexible sets can be adapted to fit in a wide variety of spaces, but smaller performing areas may require a longer load-in.
- The company requires a crossover cleared of any equipment, chairs, music stands, etc.
- Dressing rooms for eleven (11) people, the rooms should have mirrors, chairs, tables, and lights. They should be clean, lockable and ready for the company upon arrival through the end of strike.
- Toilets and sinks, with paper towels and soap must be in close proximity.
- Set: National Players travels with a self-supporting set.
- Masking: Legs and borders, preferably black. No front curtain is necessary. A black curtain (or equivalent) is required upstage of our set to be used as a crossover. Please no cycs or white backdrops.
- Availability of two or three utility tables (approximately 3' x 5') for the Company's use.
- Availability of Stage Weights or gaffer's sandbags

#### Electrical/Lighting

- Attached to this Rider is the lighting plot, cue description and paperwork. Upon arrival the company will
  provide gels and gobos and focus all lighting. PLEASE NOTE: LIGHTING PLOT, CUE DESCRIPTION, AND
  OTHER PAPERWORK WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE UNTIL September 20, 2009.
- National Players require use of a Genie Lift and/or A-Frame Ladder sufficient to access the stage lighting for focus.
- In the event that your venue is unable to provide the lighting plot provided, please notify the General Manager as soon as possible.
- National Players lighting design requires that the company run the lights from the stage-left wing area. If you are unable to relocate your board, we require one (1) technician familiar with the house system to run the board and a Clear-Com (or similar) headset to communicate between house technician and the National Players.

#### Sound

- The company will travel with its own sound system and speakers.
- Sound will be run from the stage-left wing area.
- One standard electrical outlet is required within 25' of the playing area for power supply.

#### Signing

• National Players should be notified in advance if sign language interpreters are to participate. Sign language interpreters will be located off stage right or off stage left and dimly lit with an isolated "special" blue gel to be provided and operated by the Presenter.

# Important

- All auditorium windows should be covered to insure the best possible blackout.
- Bells and speakers in the auditorium should be turned off during the performance.
